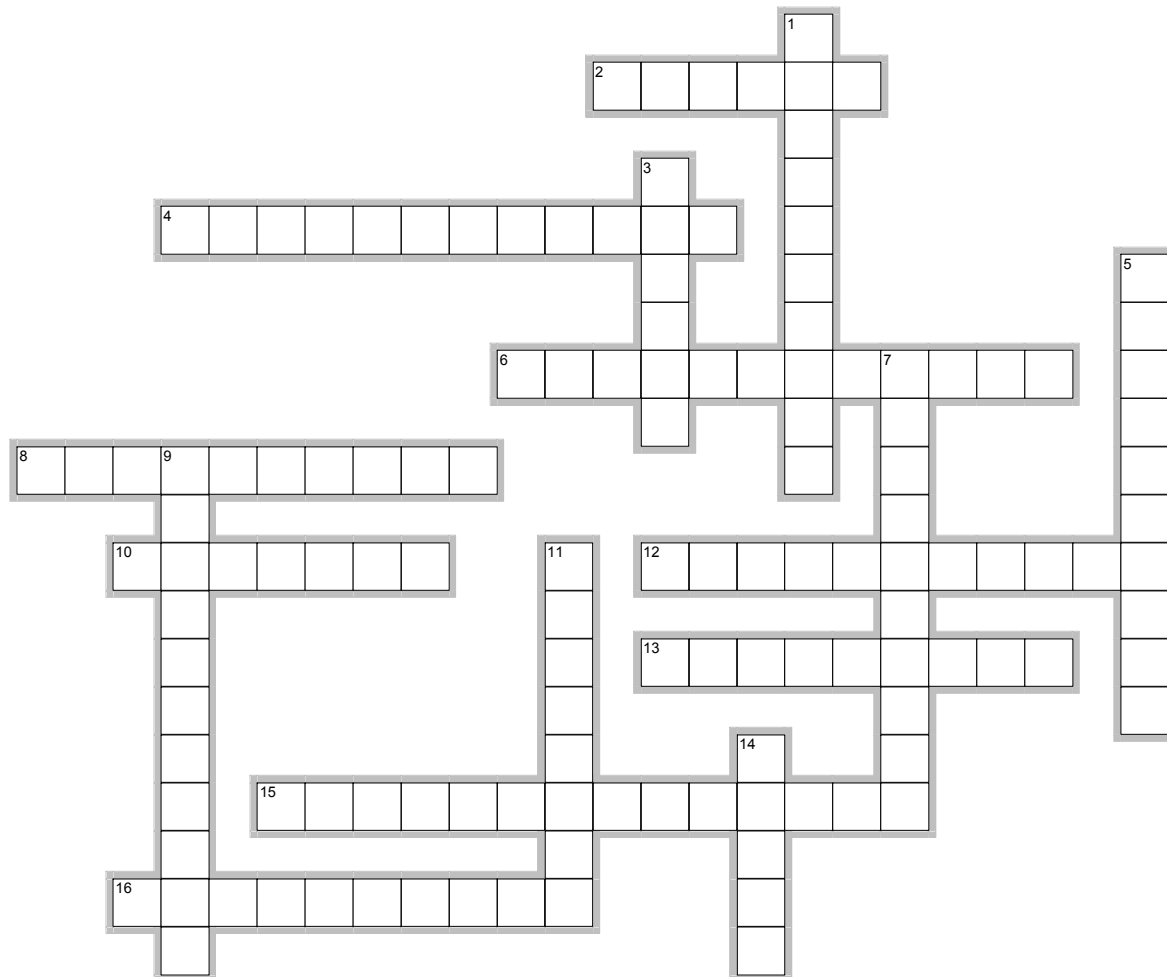


Crosswords: Trade Unions
